Project Summary:

- Locations: Patrick's Point Drive, Scenic Drive and Trinity Street
- Remove accessibility barriers on sidewalks, curb ramps, and crosswalks.
- Extend new safe and accessible pedestrian routes
- Meet the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA)

Need to provide accessible pedestrian routes to and from:

- Trinidad Library/Museum and Saunders Park
- Trinidad Town Hall
- Trinidad Elementary School
- Trinidad Bay overlook at Edwards Street

Funding:

- \$550,000 from the Regional Transportation Improvement Program
- \$30,000 contribution from the City of Trinidad

Construction Schedule:

- Summer of 2019, planning phase began
- Winter of 2019/2020, begin final design
- Spring of 2021, begin construction
